GLOBAL STUDY TRAINING PROGRAM AGREEMENT BETWEEN JAWAHARLAL NEHRU TECHNOLOGICAL UNIVERSITY-K KAKINADA, A.P, INDIA AND SMART NET WORKS INTERNATIONAL GmbH AND ASSOCIATES OF SMART NET WORKING INTERNATIONAL GmbH(Advocate Health Group, Chicago, USA.

This is the MOU only but not the final agreement. Once Terms and conditions in the MOU are accepted by all the parties involved, the final agreement format will be in action.

Smart networks International GmbH, Switzerland and Advocate Health group, Chicago, USA, in conformity with the Agreement of Cooperation between the Smart networks International GmbH, Switzerland & Advocate Health group, USA, and Jawaharlal Nehru Technological University Kakinada. This Working Agreement allows students from the Jawaharlal Nehru Technological University Kakinada to study under the auspices of the Global Study Program.

1. Definitions

- a) For the purposes of this agreement, "home" institution refers to the institution at which students intend to graduate, and "host" institution refers to the institution which has agreed to accept the students from the home institution.
- b) The Global Study Program is an academic study program that allows students from select foreign institutions share a partnership agreement to enroll in regular in the host University courses on a full-time, degree basis.

2. Purposes of the Agreement

- a) The general purpose of the agreement is to promote educational and cultural cooperation between the partnering accredited institutions and countries.
- b) The purpose of the Global Study Program is to enable students to enroll in courses at the host institution for credit which will be applied towards their degree at the home institution, as well as further students' academic and cultural enrichment and personal growth.

3. Length of Study

Students can stay at the host institution for a minimum of one semester/6 months (as field practicum), up to one full year (two semesters), to two years (Four semesters)

4. Courses to be studied:

- a) Sports Medicine
- b) Chiro Therapy
- c) Technology Transfer
- d) Research and development
- e) Post Graduation Courses
- f) Rural Health
- g) Women and Child Health
- h) Food and Nutrition.

5. Responsibilities of the Host Institution

- a) The host institution agrees to accept and enroll students as full-time, students for the duration of the agreement.
- b) The host institution will allow Global Study students to enroll in a broad range of courses in nearly all the colleges and departments across campus.
- c) The host institution will provide each student with an Orientation Program and ongoing academic oversight, advising and support. Program advisors also maintain close coordination with the home institution.
- d) The host institution will provide intensive English language

- (or students will learn German) and pre-academic courses for Global Study students as needed. The needed expenditure is the responsibility of the student.
- e) The host institution will provide each student with access to the host University facilities and privileges, including but not limited to:
 - libraries, sports and recreational facilities, the university transportation system, and the student health center etc.
- f) The host institution is responsible for sending course transcripts to the home institution and Global Study students, including the subject titles, credits, and grades.
- g) In the administration of the Global Study Program, the host institution will not be expected to take any action which will be contrary to its academic regulations and practices.

6. Responsibilities of the Home Institution

a) The home institution will select students for the Global Study Program with high academic standing at their home institution (i.e., a grade point average of A/B or better and the recommendations of their home university) and demonstrated academic preparation for college-level academic study in English.

b) The home institution will have the responsibility for all matters concerning the transfer and recognition of credits for coursework taken at the host institution.

7. Responsibilities of Global Study Students

- a) Global Study students are responsible for meeting the host institution's academic standards.
- b) It will be the responsibility of each student to obtain official recognition from his or her home institution for credit earned at the host institution.
- c) Global Study students are responsible for adhering to all US legal requirements in order to maintain their immigration status, including continuous registration as full-time students.
- d) Global Study students will be responsible for ensuring that the following fees are paid:
 - Tuition and program fees
 - Travel to and from the host institution
 - Course materials and textbooks
 - Travel documentation and visas
 - Housing and other living expenses
 - Medical insurance coverage

Students will be responsible for obtaining medical/health insurance coverage to the satisfaction of the host institution.

8. Student Conduct

Global Study students will be subject to the rules and regulations of the host institution. Any breach of these rules will be dealt with in accordance with the disciplinary policy of the host university.

9. Accommodation

Every effort will be made to assist students to obtain housing within a reasonable distance of the host campus. Students must be aware that they are responsible for all costs associated with housing.

10. Responsible Administrative Personnel

The Host University or the Institute of the Global Study Program is administered by the respective Host University. The Host University provides academic oversight, facilitates the application and registration process, and distributes transcripts.

The designated operational units of the parties, for purposes of administering the terms of this agreement are:

11. Period of Agreement

This agreement will be effective from the date of signature of both parties and will remain in force for an initial period of five years,

and may be renewed by mutual agreement. The agreement will be terminated by either party with six months written notice.

Program details are outlined in Attachment A, and will be updated on an annual basis and as needed.

12. Signature
