# Candidates can download hall tickets from April 18

- About 2.75 lakh candidates apply for Eamcet
- Eamcet (engineering) exam will be held from Apr 22 to 24
- The exam for medical and agriculture courses will be conducted between 10 am and 5 pm on April 25

**Kakinada:** Engineering Agriculture and Medical Common Entrance Test (EAMCET) would be held from April 22 to 25, said JNTU Vice-Chancellor and AP Eamcet Chairman Prof S Rama Krishna Rao.

In a press release here on Friday, he revealed the details of the test. He said that this is the fourth time that

the JNTU is conducting the prestigious examination and the second time it is being held through an online system. He said that the examination for the engineering courses would start on April 22 and conclude on April 24. While the exam for the agriculture and medical courses would be held between 10 am and 5 pm on April 25. He further informed that so far they received 2,74,756 applications for the exam for all the courses.

He said that they received 1,98,112 applications for engineering, 75,550 applications for medical and 1094 applications for both the examinations.

The Vice-Chancellor specified that for the determination of Eamcet ranks

they would give weightage to the Intermediate marks and allotted 25 per cent weightage for Inter marks.

He informed that those who had already applied for the examination can download their hall tickets from April 18. He said that they allotted the examination centres which the applicants had opted for in majority cases while a few changes were made for some applicants.

All the applicants should be on time and they won't allow any latecomers even if they late by a minute.
