Ball Badminton (Men & Women) Tournament

1. Venue of the Tournament:

The Tournament will be held at Jawaharlal Nehru Technological University Kakinada, Kakinada, E.G. Dist., Andhra Pradesh which is located 2.5 Km away from Kakinada Railway Station / Bus Stand.

2. Dates of Tournament: 4th to 6th December 2018.

3. Accommodation and hospitality:

The teams will be provided with unfurnished accommodation 12 hours prior to the commencement of the tournament. The food will be provided free of Cost on 4-12-2018 morning to 6-12-2018 evening to all the participants by the organizers. The teams are informed to make their own arrangements for beddings and locks.

4. Rules of the Competition:

The Tournament will be played as per the Ball Badminton Federation of India latest rules and the guidelines of the AIU will be followed for the tournament. The organizing Secretary reserves the right to make changes in the Programme and the venue, if necessary. The decision of the committee shall be final and binding.

5. Eligibility:

6. Manager's Meeting:

Team Managers and Coaches meeting will be held on 3rd December, 2018, at 5.00 P.M. in the Office of the University Sports Council, Jawaharlal Nehru Technological University Kakinada, wherein the fixtures will be drawn.

7. Inaugural Function:

All the participating teams are requested to bring the Flags of their Universities, which is most essential and compulsory for March fast which will be held on 4th December, 2018 at 09.30 A.M. at Jawaharlal Nehru Technological University Kakinada campus.

8. Precautions to be taken by the Team Managers:

The weather will be normal during the morning and evening. The night climate will be slightly cool, the teams are instructed to bring adequate clothing. The team managers are totally responsible for their players discipline during competition and stay.

Know about Kakinada – The Port City

Kakinada is a city and a municipal corporation in the Indian state of Andhra Pradesh. It is the largest city urban agglomeration and the headquarters of East Godavari district. This coastal city is witnessing rapid growth due to the recently granted Special Economic Zone status. The city also has a deep-water port which is expanding rapidly. This city is the most well planned city in Asia after Chandigarh. The presence of a small island called Hope Island about 5 km from Kakinada coast, makes Kakinada a natural Harbor. Prior to construction of the deep water port, the old anchorage port operated for several decades as the largest minor port in India. At present, both the deep water port and older anchorage port operate side by side.

Kakinada is the "Fertilizer City" of Andhra Pradesh. Nagarjuna Fertilizers is the biggest Urea manufacturer in coastal Andhra while Godavari Fertilizers produces DAP (Di-Ammonium Phosphate). Kakinada has been in the news recently after several oil companies decided to use this as a transit point for oil and gas shipments. The economic value of these investments has increased considerably after the recent mega gas finds by Reliance in the KG basin. The recently accorded SEZ status is an indicator of the immense potential for economic growth in this area. The city has one of the oldest Engineering campuses in Andhra Pradesh, the JNTU Engineering College popularly known as Engineering College, Kakinada (ECK) (estd. 1944), which is a part of the Jawaharlal Nehru Technological University system.

How To Get There

Kakinada, the headquarters of East Godavari district is well connected by rail and road. The port of Kakinada serves coastal traffic.

Road: Kakinada is located 60 kms from Rajahmundry and 162 kms from Visakhapatnam. It is well connected by Road.

Rail: Kakinada is connected to Samalkot Junction (12 km) which is on the Chennai-Howrah trunk line, where almost all express trains stop to connect Kakinada with the important places of the country. Kakinada is 60 kms from Rajahmundry Railway station and 162 kms from Visakhapatnam Railway Station.
