INTER-COLLEGIATE TOURNAMENTS 2018-19

A. Eligibility Rules:

1. Only a bonafide student, who is currently enrolled / registered for a degree whose status is recognized by the appropriate authority, which is of a minimum duration of one academic year and whose examination is conducted by the university shall be eligible to participate in Inter Collegiate Tournaments and fulfill the following conditions.
2. Foreign students are eligible to participate only in the Inter Collegiate Tournaments, the total number of foreign players in a team should not be more than 10% of the team. However for small teams, where the total number of players is less than 10 members one foreign student can be allowed in the team.
3. All eligible students while participating in Inter Collegiate Tournaments shall fulfill the following essential conditions.
4. He / She should be less than 25 years of age as on 1st July of that academic year. The participant age shall be minimum 17 years and maximum up to 25 years as per AIU rules.
5. Not more than 8 years have elapsed since a student passed the examination qualifying him/ her for first admission to a degree course of university or college affiliated to a university.
6. The eight years eligibility period for participation of students in competitions shall be distributed as under:-
7. (i) Not more than five years after passing 10+2 or equivalent examination while studying in Under Graduate Courses/ Studies.

(ii) Not more than three years after passing Graduate or equivalent examination while studying in Post Graduate Courses/ Studies. Irrespective of any other conditions like change of class/course/faculty, joining lower class from higher, changing academic to professional course or vice versa, provided the student admitted, after passing +2 examination, to graduate course of more than 3 years duration like Medical, Engineering, Agriculture, Pharmacy etc. shall be eligible to participate in the Inter-University tournaments for the actual length of such graduate courses/studies.

B. Tournament Rules:

1. The Tournament will be conducted as per the Rules and Regulation of the **concerned Federation & AIU**.
2. The participating colleges have to send their consent letter to the Organizing Secretary seven days before the commencement of the Tournament. No entry is allowed after wards.
3. For the events Chess & Ball Badminton, the participating Colleges have to submit the eligibility proforma in triplicate with complete information in all respects **duly signed by the Principal**, to the Organizing Secretary one day before the commencement of the tournament.
4. The participating teams have to produce their **Identity Cards** without fail on demand and carry along with them during the course of the tournament.
5. The **TA & DA** for the participating players is to be borne by the **respective colleges**.
6. The players should maintain **Self-Discipline** throughout the tournament and it is the **responsibility of the Faculty of Physical Education of the concerned colleges to control their students**.
7. The **Uniform/Players Dress** with **college name** and **numbers** is **compulsory**.
8. All the participating teams should participate in the **March-Past** with proper Uniform.
9. Every College should carry their College Flag during the March Past.
10. The players should **report** at the ground at least **30 minutes** before the commencement of the Match.
11. The participating colleges have to **pay Rs.500/- per college** towards security deposit. This amount will be repaid at the time of taking the participation certificate from the Organizing Secretary by deducting the cost of the damages by the players if any.
12. **Entry fee Rs. 500/- will be collected.**
13. Entries without Entry fee will not be entertained.
14. The organizing secretary will be conducted a meeting of the Team Managers one day before the commencement of the Tournament.
15. The Organizing Committee reserves the rights to make changes in the programme to suit its convenience. The decision of the Organizing Committee shall be final with regard to matters concerning the tournament.

C. Fixtures Committee:

In accordance with the rules of the AIU the concerned Organizing Secretary of the Inter Collegiate Tournament has to call for the fixtures committee meeting with the following members to draw the fixtures transparently:

- a. Chairman: Principal of the concerned college
- b. Observer: University Nominee
- c. Convener: Assistant Professor of Physical Education of the college.
- d. Members:
 1. Organizing Secretary of previous year Inter Collegiate Tournament
 2. One Senior most Assist. Prof of Physical Education in Particular Zone

Note: Any objections regarding fixtures will be entertained during the fixtures committee meeting, once the fixtures are drawn and finalized by the fixtures committee, No grievance/protest is allowed on drawn fixtures.

D. Protest Rule:

1. Protest against the decision of an umpire on a point of rule and protest of any other nature in connection with conduct of tournament shall be in writing and must reach the Organizing Secretary along with protest fee **Rs. 1500/-** only within **“Two Hours”** of the conclusion of the concerned match / tournament for consideration of the **“Jury of Appeal”** for an appropriate necessary action, then and there/on the spot, in this regard.
2. In case of any indiscipline or misconduct by any individual player(s) or a team as a whole, the Organizing Committee shall have the powers to even scratch the team(s) or disqualify the individual players(s) from participation in the concerned tournament. Further doing so, however, Organizing Committee shall strictly follow the procedure as laid down.
 - (i) Both teams / Sportspersons involved in the dispute will be given an equal opportunity to explain their respective view point.
 - (ii) The meeting will be presided over by chairman of the Organizing Committee of the concerned Tournament.
 - (iii) The matter will be reported immediately to University. If it is deemed necessary to make an **“on the spot enquiry”** of the incident.
 - (iv) The decision shall be taken by the Jury of Appeal, then and there, strictly in accordance with existing rules and regulation of the AIU.

E. Disqualification Rule:

1. Any disqualification of a sportsperson on the grounds of ineligibility in team games results into automatic scratching of his/her team for that academic year and the college will be penalized with Rs.10,000/- each case and the issue will be reported to the Principal of concerned College. In case of individual events, the ineligible candidate" be debarred from the participation in any Inter Collegiate Tournaments in future and the matter should be reported to the Principal of the concerned College with penalty of Rs.10000/- per each case of ineligible candidate.
2. The host college shall have the power to debar the athletes(s) or scratch the team(s), if found guilty for their involvement in the incidents of violence during the Inter Collegiate Tournaments after following due process of independent enquiry and if necessary recommend to the concerned colleges to cancel the admission of such defaulting persons.
3. Those sportspersons who are tested and found positive alcoholic during the Inter Collegiate Tournaments results into automatic scratching of his / her team for the academic year and recommend to the concerned colleges to cancel the admission of the such defaulting persons.

F. Award of Points & Championships Rule:

1. Rule for the awarding points for Central Zone/Single Zone Girls Meet:

- Knock Out Tournament
- Add line Match should be conducted to adjudge the 3rd place
- The following procedure must be adopted while awarding the points.

Winner: 10 Points

Runner: 6 Points

Third: 2 Points

I. Team Championships:

1. All Round Athletic Champions for Men
2. All Round Athletic Champions for Women
3. All Round Games Champions for Men:
4. All Round Games Champions for Women:

- ❖ The college securing the highest number of points shall be declared champions. In case of a tie, the college winning the more number of first places shall be adjudged as champion college.

II. Over All Championship (Hon'ble Vice Chancellor Trophy)

The maximum of 25% of points will be considered from each championship to adjudge the winner of Hon'ble Vice Chancellor Trophy.

Volley ball

- The rules as adopted by Volley ball Federation of India shall be followed
- The matches will be conducted on Knock out basis.
- A team shall consist of Maximum 12 players only
- Only one team is allowed from each college
- Entry Fee Rs. 500/- will be collected per team

Basket ball:

- The rules as adopted by Basket ball Federation of India shall be followed.
- The matches will be conducted on Knock out basis.
- A team shall consist of Maximum 12 players only
- Only one team is allowed from each college
- Entry Fee Rs. 500/- will be collected per team

Table Tennis:

- The rules as adopted Table Tennis Federation of India shall be followed.
- The Tournament shall be conduct as team event
- All Matches shall be played best of three games only
- A team shall consist of Maximum 5 players only
- The teams have to purchase tournament quality balls from the Org, Secretary
- Only one team is allowed from each college
- Entry Fee Rs. 500/- will be collected per team

Shuttle Badminton:

- The rules as adopted Badminton Federation of India shall be followed.
- The Tournament shall be conduct as team event
- All Matches shall be played best of three games only
- A team shall consist of Maximum 5 players only
- The teams have to purchase tournament quality shuttle from the Org, Secretary
- Only one team is allowed from each college
- Entry Fee Rs. 500/- will be collected per team

Kabaddi:

- a. The rules as adopted by AIU, AKFI shall be followed.
- b. The matches will be conducted on Knock out basis.
- c. A team shall consist of Maximum 12 players only
- d. Only one team is allowed from each college
- e. Weight criteria should not be greater than 85kg for men, women 75kg.
- f. Entry Fee Rs. 500/- will be collected per team

Throw ball:

- a. The rules as adopted by Throw ball Federation of India shall be followed
- b. The matches will be conducted on Knock out basis.
- c. All the Matches will be played best of three sets only
- d. A team shall consist of Maximum 12 players only
- e. Only one team is allowed from each college
- f. Entry Fee Rs. 500/- will be collected per team

Chess:

- a. The Tournament will be played according to the latest FIDE Rules
- b. Swiss method will be followed
- c. A team shall consist 5 members
- d. Only one team is allowed from each college
- e. Entry Fee Rs. 500/- will be collected per team

Ball Badminton:

- a. The rules as adopted Ball Badminton Federation of India shall be followed.
- b. All Matches shall be played best of three games only
- c. A team shall consist of Maximum 10 players only
- d. The teams have to purchase tournament quality balls from the Org, Secretary
- e. Only one team is allowed from each college
- f. Entry Fee Rs. 500/- will be collected per team

Kho-Kho

- a. The rules as adopted by Kho-Kho Federation of India shall be followed.
- b. The matches will be conducted on Knock out basis.
- c. A team shall consist of Maximum 12 players only
- d. Only one team is allowed from each college
- e. Entry Fee Rs. 500/- will be collected per team

Duties of the Scrutiny Committee:

- The Committee should scrutiny the Eligibility Form
- Eligibility Form should be typed neatly. It should not be in hand writing.
- Eligibility Form should duly signed by the concerned Principal of the College. Without Principal sign team will not be allowed to participate in the tournament.
- Any Unauthorized over writing on the typed eligibility form should be certified by the competent authority.
- Identity cards in given format must be carried by all the participants.
- During the Tournament scrutiny committee can check the Id cards of any player.

Note: The Organizing Secretary has to send the two **Video CDs** (total video coverage on starting to end of the tournament) and detailed Report of the Tournament Soon after the completion of the tournament to the University.
