Sub: Higher Education – Hon'ble Chief Minister Teleconference at 8.00 A.M. on 20.09.2016 on communicable disease –Instructions issued – Reg.

It is to inform that the Hon'ble Chief Minister of Andhra Pradesh has conducted teleconference with Principal Secretaries / HODs of certain Departments on 20.09.2016 and instructed on the action to be taken to prevent and control communicable diseases.

Vector borne diseases like Malaria, Chikungunia, Filariasis, Dengue, etc., and other communicable diseases i.e. air borne and water borne like Swine flu, Jaundice, Cholera, Typhoid, etc., can be kept under control and prevented by keeping premises clean and hygienic.

In this connection, the following instructions are issued for strict compliance:

- (1) Awareness campaign by the title "Domalapai Dandayatra – Parisarala Parishubratha" should be taken up on a war footing basis.
  - (a) They shall be 10 – 15 minutes awareness speeches by the Teachers, Local Doctors etc. on communicable diseases and the ways and means by which they can be controlled and prevented
  - (b) The booklets prepared on this subject by the Government should be made available to the student community and they shall be encouraged to bring about awareness among at least 10 families each.
  - (c) The College / University premises can be kept clear of unwanted weeds, garbage etc. It shall be ensured that there is no stagnated water (both Drinking & Drainage).
  - (d) Awareness to be enhanced to do away with open defecation and to make A.P Open Defecation Free State (ODF State).
- (2) The flagship campaigns i.e. (1) Vanam – Manam (2) Water Conservation (3) Swatcha Andhra Pradesh be celebrated / taken to public on massive scale
- (3) The above programmes can be taken up in a mission mode through the following -
  - (a) Discussions / discourses of about 10 – 15 minutes during the prayer / Public Assembling time of the Institutions
  - (b) Rallies to be taken up by the students with the support of the Teachers
  - (c) Massive Planting programme involving students.
  - (d) Taking selfies and posting them in the "Kaizala App"
  - (e) Involving the NSS and NCC volunteers to keep their institution campuses clean

- (f) The roof tops of building should be got cleaned of leaf litter and other waste to avoid dampness, water logging on the roofs.

The above mentioned flag ship programmes should be conducted with commitment from 21.09.2016 to 24.09.2016. They shall be a massive campaign / rally programme on the 4<sup>th</sup> Saturday (24.09.2016) by all the Institutions.

Apart from the above, the HoDs and Vice Chancellors of the Universities are requested to take up teleconference/video conference with their principals/Teachers etc., immediately.


