

Ganta releases AP Eamcet paper code

- Directs officials to allow aspirants who come late to examination centre if they give genuine reason
- Preliminary key will be released on April 25

Kakinada: Minister for Human Resources Development Ganta Srinivasa Rao released Eamcet-2018 paper code (E9) at the JNTU meeting hall here on Sunday.

Speaking on the occasion, the minister said the government has been conducting Eamcet examination in online system since 2017 and informed that 1,423 examination centres have been set up across the state including three centres in Telangana state.

He directed the officials to allow the aspirants who come late to examination centre if they say genuine reason.

He said the government had received 2,75,995 applications for

this year's Eamcet including 1,99,309 applications for engineering and 76,686 applications for agriculture and medicine courses.

He said the exams would be completed on April 25 and examination key would be released on April 25 in AP Eamcet website. They would allow objections from students till 5 pm on April 27. He advised the students to

come at least half an hour before to examination centre and should check their computers whether they are functioning well or not.

Amalapuram MP Pandula Ravindra Babu, MLAs Venkateswara Rao, Anantha Lakshmi, JNTU in-charge VC and AP Eamcet Chairman Prof Rama Krishna Rao, Registrar Subba Rao and Rector Purnanandam were present.

EAMCET key on April 25, results on May 3

The state government will release the key for the Andhra Pradesh EAMCET-2018 on April 25 and results will be declared on May 3.

The government has also exempted a one-minute delay condition. The students can attend the exam, even though it is one or two minutes late if they give an appropriate reason. The Andhra Pradesh EAMCET examinations started on

Sunday and the examinations will be held until April 25.

"The EAMCET key would be displayed in the official website. The student's answer sheet and key would be mailed to them. The students can compare the key and their answer sheets and if there are any objections, the EAMCET office will receive it on 5 pm of April 27. After pursuing the objections, the result would be declared on May 3," said EAMCET convener Ch.

Saibabu.

He said that as many as 62,274 students of 65,534 (95.02 per cent) attended the examination on Sunday, the first day and 3,260 students did not attend the test. He said that students can get admissions into B. Tech, biotechnology, dairy technology, agriculture engineering, food science and technology, B. Sc agriculture, B. Pharmacy and pharma-D courses by qualifying in Andhra Pradesh EAMCET.

Meanwhile, human resources minister Ganta Srinivasa Rao released a set code on Sunday morning at Jawaharlal Nehru Technological University Kakinada (JNTUK) in the presence of Amalapuram MP P. Ravindra Babu, Kakinada MLA Vanamadi Venkateswara Rao (Kondababu) and vice chancellor in-charge S. Ramakrishna Rao and others.

He said that the government is taking steps for

conducting examinations early to curb migration of students studying engineering and other courses in other states.

He said that this year also, the government will start engineering classes early. He added that a calendar has been made ready for conducting all examinations adding that though the state faces a financial deficit of ₹16,000 crore, the government has allocated more funds to the education department.
