## Internship training to help engineering students

### ■ JNTUK, UCEK to start six to eight week sessions

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KAKINADA, APRIL 28

Jawaharlal Nehru Technological University Kakinada (JNTUK) and University College of Engineering Kakinada (UCEK) are jointly organising six-to-eight week long internship training for students of B.Tech and M.Tech.

The training sessions will be held at the Siemens Center of Excellence (COE) of Andhra Pradesh Skill Development Corporation. Students of mechanical, electrical, instrumentation and electronics engineering as well as those who have completed the courses are eligible to apply for the programme.

The training would be given on computer aided design (CAD), computer aided engineering (CAE), LMS,

CNC programming and machining (CNC), digital manufacturing and industrial robotics, industrial automation, electrical and energy studies, mechatronics and energy studies.

The JNTUK IIP and SD director and SDC chief coordinator L. Sumalatha said that training would also be given on technical skills, soft skills and entrepreneurship skills beside other wings. For the summer internship

courses, students from East and West Godavari districts can also participate.

He said that students who want to join the summer internship training should apply on or before May 1, along with aadhar details through [www.apssc-siemens.in](http://www.apssc-siemens.in) website. The students will be required to attend training along with their SSC marks list, Aadhar card, engineering certificate

She said that the training sessions would be from 9 am to 5 pm on all working days. Students need to pay Rs.3,000 for six weeks courses and Rs.4,000 for eight week courses.

JNTUK Vice-Chancellor M. Ramalinga Raju said after completing the training, the APSSDC-Siemens-Certificates which secured international recognition would be given. He said that a job mela would be organised as part of the summer internship programme. He said that a separate building would be provided for Skill Development especially and also provided infrastructure facilities. He said that due to the skill development courses, the students can grow their ideas and initiate start-ups with their innovative thoughts.
