Undergraduate Highlights

- + Accounting and Business Analytic programs have a STEM designation from the U.S. Department of Education for possessing quantitative analysis and data science technologies courses in the curriculum.
- + Our John Pappajohn Entrepreneurial Center, which includes the R. J. McElroy Student Business Incubator, is housed right on campus and is a centralized hub for entrepreneurial resources, programs and collaboration.
- + UNI is the first university in Iowa to use SynDavers, which are synthetic human cadavers, and we'll soon be the first school in the world to receive the new Generation 3 SynDavers.

Scholarships / 2022-23

Priority deadline for most scholarships is January 15. Submit application at finaid.uni.edu/scholarships. Students can qualify for multiple scholarships, and scholarships are renewable and stackable.

Undergraduate Students

INTERNATIONAL SCHOLAR AWARD

Automatically awarded to qualifying freshmen applicants. Students can only qualify for one scholarship.

+ **\$5,000/year** – 1130+ SAT or 3.7+ GPA

+ **\$3,000/year** – 1020-1120 SAT or 3.5 GPA

INTERNATIONAL EXCEL AWARD

+ **\$1,000–\$6,000/year**

+ Awards based on academic background and scholarship essay

UNI BUSINESS SCHOLAR AWARD

For students planning to major in business

+ **Up to \$1,000/year** – 1200+ SAT and 3.5+ GPA

UNI TRANSFER SCHOLAR AWARD

Automatically awarded to qualifying transfer applicants.

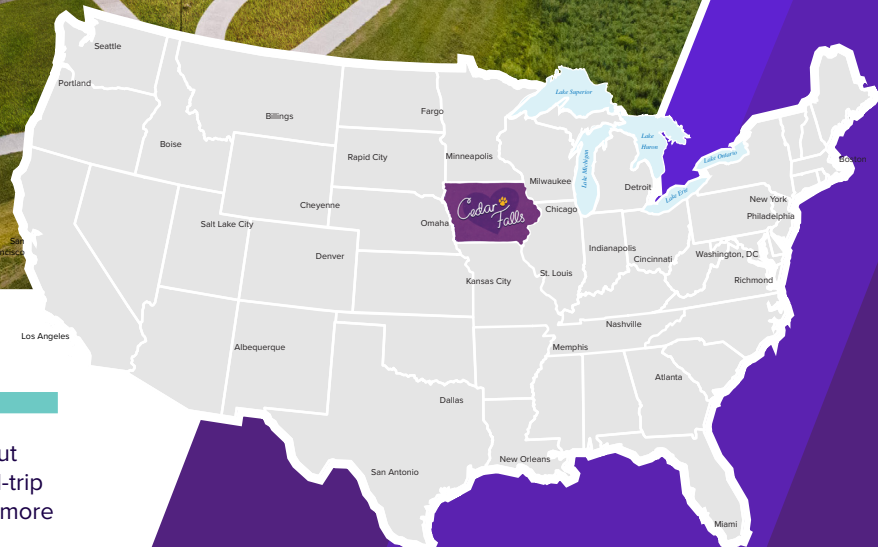
