The following instructions are to be taken care of by the participating Universities.

1. The AIU South Zone Kho-Kho (Men) Championship commences on 09.01.2023. (Teams to report on 08.01.2023)
2. Every team shall remit an amount of Rs. 3000/- as Registration Fee to the Association of Indian Universities for being eligible to participate in the South Zone Inter University Kho-Kho Championship for Men 2022-2023. The managers shall remit the receipt of the same countersigned by the Director of Sports of the University concerned along with 4 copies of eligibility form and supporting documents at the reception counter of the championship.
3. The Inauguration of AIU South Zone Kho-Kho (Men) Championship will be held on 09.01.2023. All the participating Universities are requested to instruct their teams to be present on the occasion along with the Manager and Coach.
4. All the participating Universities have to bring their University flag for the Inaugural function.
5. Team managers meeting will be held on 08.01.2023 at 4.00 Pm at the JNTUK Indoor Stadium.
6. All the managers are requested to attend the meeting along with 4 sets of eligibility forms, S.S.C Marks sheet and +2 Marks sheet, (Degree marks sheet in case of PG studies) duly attested by the competent authorities, without fail.
7. All the matches will be played on Mud both in day light and flood lights.
8. The timings of the matches shall be from 07.00 am to 09.00 pm on all the days of the tournament (Kindly refer fixtures and match schedule copies).
9. The matches will be played on Knock-out cum league basis. The teams are expected to report with proper uniforms as suggested by AIU.
10. Each Team shall have to pay an officiating charge of Rs.1500/- per match as per the rules of AIU.
12. Universities who have not paid the subscription to AIU, for the year 2022 - 23 will not be allowed to participate in the tournament, as per the circular issued by AIU, New Delhi.
13. All the Teams shall report at least 30 minutes before the commencement of their Match, otherwise their opponent team shall be awarded walkover as per the Championship rules. (The teams which fail to report in time will be given Walkover.)

14. The tournament will be conducted as per the latest rules of the Kho-Kho Federation of India as adopted by Association of Indian Universities, New Delhi. The teams are expected to report with proper uniforms as suggested by the Association of Indian Universities. The Championship will be played in 15+2 Patron, (i.e. 15 Players + 1 Coach & 1 Manager)
15. The Organizing Committee reserves the right to make changes (to pre-pone/post-pone/ curtail) in the Championship Program, if any, as and when required, in consultation with Referees. However, prior intimation will be given to the managers for effecting such changes.
16. The decisions of the officials shall be final and binding. Appeals, if any, shall be decided by the jury of appeal. A participating team may lodge protest on technical matters, within 30 Minutes of the completion of their match along with protest fee of Rs. 2000/-.
17. The teams shall produce their players ID cards as and when required by the organizers.
18. Team Managers are responsible for their players to maintain absolute discipline during the tournament and at the place of accommodation.
19. The Decision of the Organizing Committee shall be final and binding in all the matters concerned. The Teams will be provided unfurnished accommodation (Dormitory type with floor carpets) 24 hours before the commencement of their respective matches and the teams have to vacate within 24 hours after losing their last match in the Championship. (Teams arriving early & departing late shall make their own arrangements of overstay)
20. The Teams are informed to make their own arrangements for boarding and locks.
21. Participating Universities are requested to inform their teams' travel schedule to the Organizing Secretary well in advance so as to arrange accommodation for their teams.
22. The climate during the tournament (night) will be chill & hence players shall bring adequate winter clothes & Bed sheets.
23. Unfurnished accommodation will be provided to the participating teams. Each team should deposit a sum of Rs. 2,000/- (Rupees Two Thousands only) as caution deposit. This amount will be refunded after adjusting the cost of damages, if any at the time of checkout. The losing teams shall have to vacate within 24 hours after their last match is over.
24. Smoking and use of Alcohol/similar substance are strictly prohibited campus and in the tournament venue. Those who are found using will be (team) expelled from the Tournament without further enquiry.

25. Location of the Venue: The nearest railway station is Samalkota Junction Howrah trunk line, where almost all express trains stop to connect Kakinada with the important places of the country. From Samalkota to JNTU Kakinada campus is 21 KM. Every 5 Minutes there is bus facility and frequently Autos are available.
26. Reception counter will be functioning at Samalkota Railway Station from 08.01.2023 at 8 AM onwards.
27. For the convenience of visiting teams transportation will be provided on nominal payment from Samalkota Railway Station to JNTUK Kakinada
28. All the participating teams are requested to inform of their arrival date, and time to the Organizing Secretary in advance to make necessary arrangements.
29. The Technical Official's decision is final and binding at all stages of the tournament.
30. Organizing Secretary reserves the right to make changes of the venue, date and time of the Tournament.

Know about Kakinada – The Port City

Kakinada is a city and a municipal corporation in the Indian state of Andhra Pradesh. It is the largest city urban agglomeration and the headquarters of East Godavari district. This coastal city is witnessing rapid growth due to the recently granted Special Economic Zone status. The city also has a deep-water port which is expanding rapidly. This city is the most well planned city in Asia after Chandigarh. The presence of a small island called Hope Island about 5 km from Kakinada coast, makes Kakinada a natural Harbor. Prior to construction of the deep water port, the old anchorage port operated for several decades as the largest minor port in India. At present, both the deep water port and older anchorage port operate side by side.

Kakinada is the “Fertilizer City” of Andhra Pradesh. Nagarjuna Fertilizers is the biggest Urea manufacturer in coastal Andhra while Godavari Fertilizers produces DAP(Di-Ammonium Phosphate). Kakinada has been in the news recently after several oil companies decided to use this as a transit point for oil and gas shipments. The economic value of these investments has increased considerably after the recent mega gas finds by Reliance in the KG basin. The recently accorded SEZ status is an indicator of the immense potential for economic growth in this area.

The city has one of the oldest Engineering campuses in Andhra Pradesh, the JNTU Engineering College popularly known as Engineering College, Kakinada (ECK) (estd. 1944), which is a part of the Jawaharlal Nehru Technological University system.

How To Reach Kakinada

Kakinada, the headquarters of East Godavari district is well connected by rail and road. The port of Kakinada serves coastal traffic.

Air : The nearest airport is located at Rajahmundry about 65 km from the city has services to Hyderabad and Visakhapatnam. Kingfisher Airlines is the airlines operating here. The nearest International airport is at Visakhapatnam at a distance of 145 km and has the services of all major airline operators to all big cities in the country.

Road : Kakinada is located 60 kms from Rajahmundry and 162 kms from Visakhapatnam. It is well connected by Road.

Rail : Kakinada is connected to Samalkot Junction (12 km) which is on the Chennai-Howrah trunk line, where almost all express trains stop to connect Kakinada with the important places of the country. Kakinada is 60 kms from Rajahmundry Railway station and 162 kms from Visakhapatnam Railway Station.

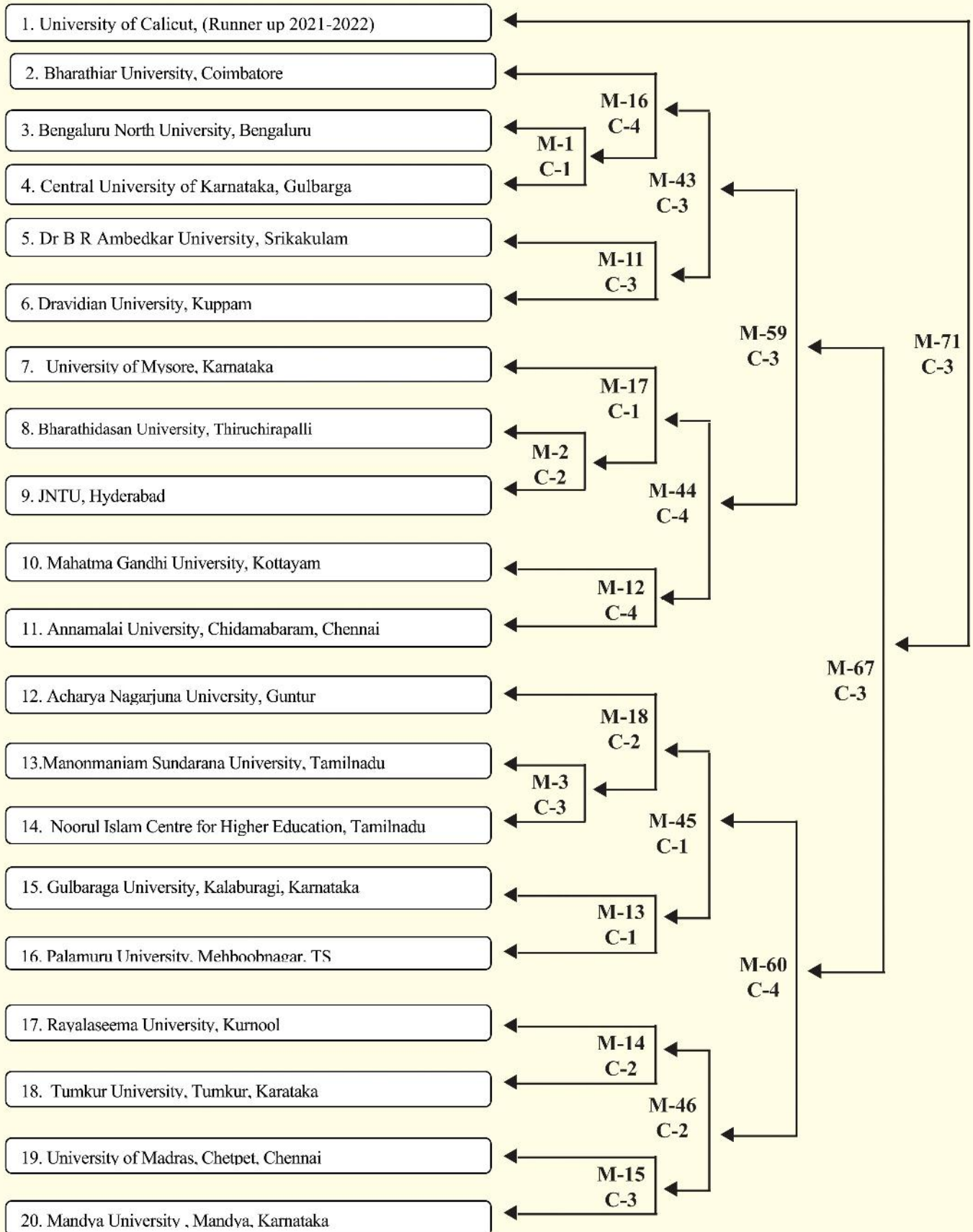
Kakinada is a pilgrimage center in Andhra Pradesh.

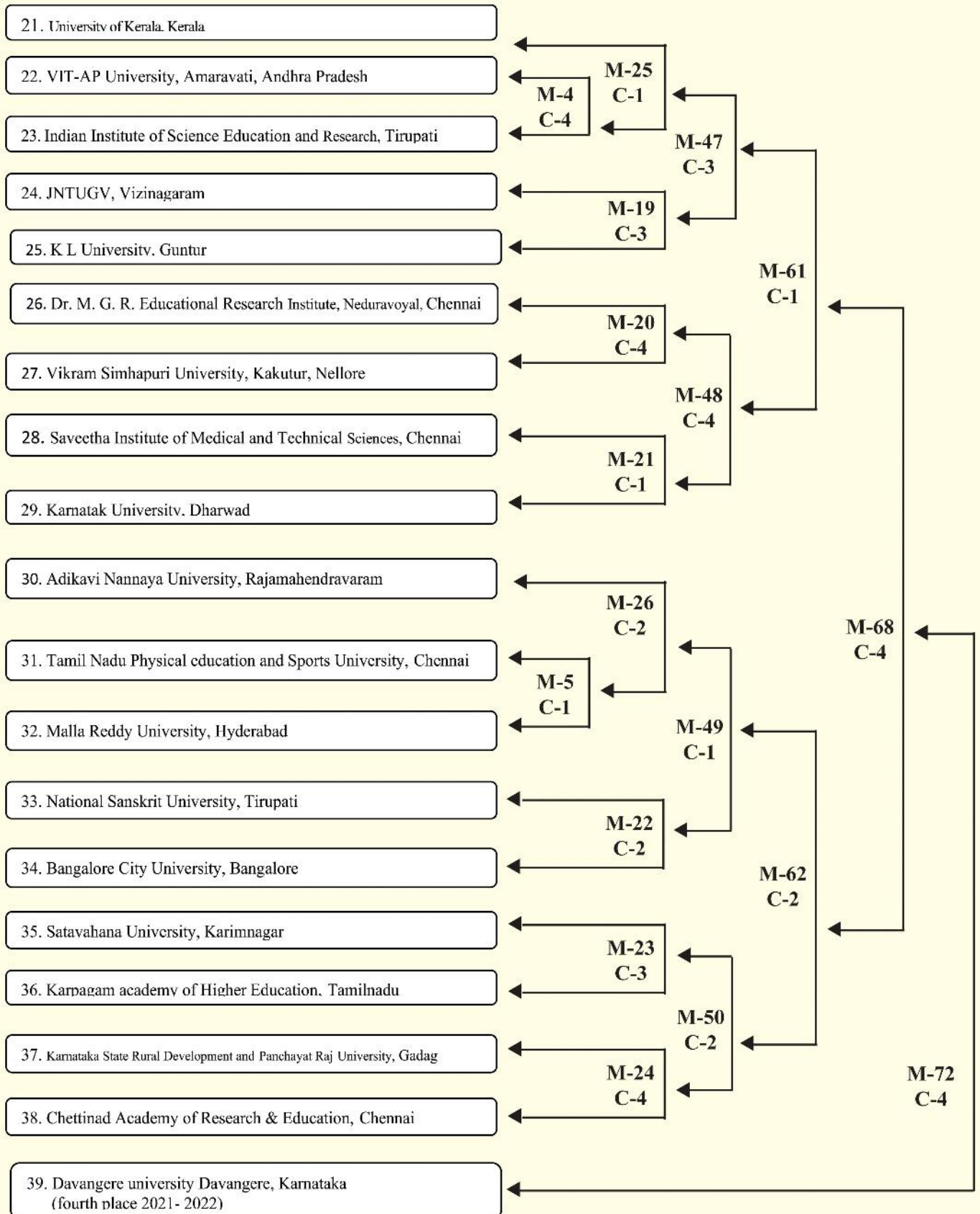

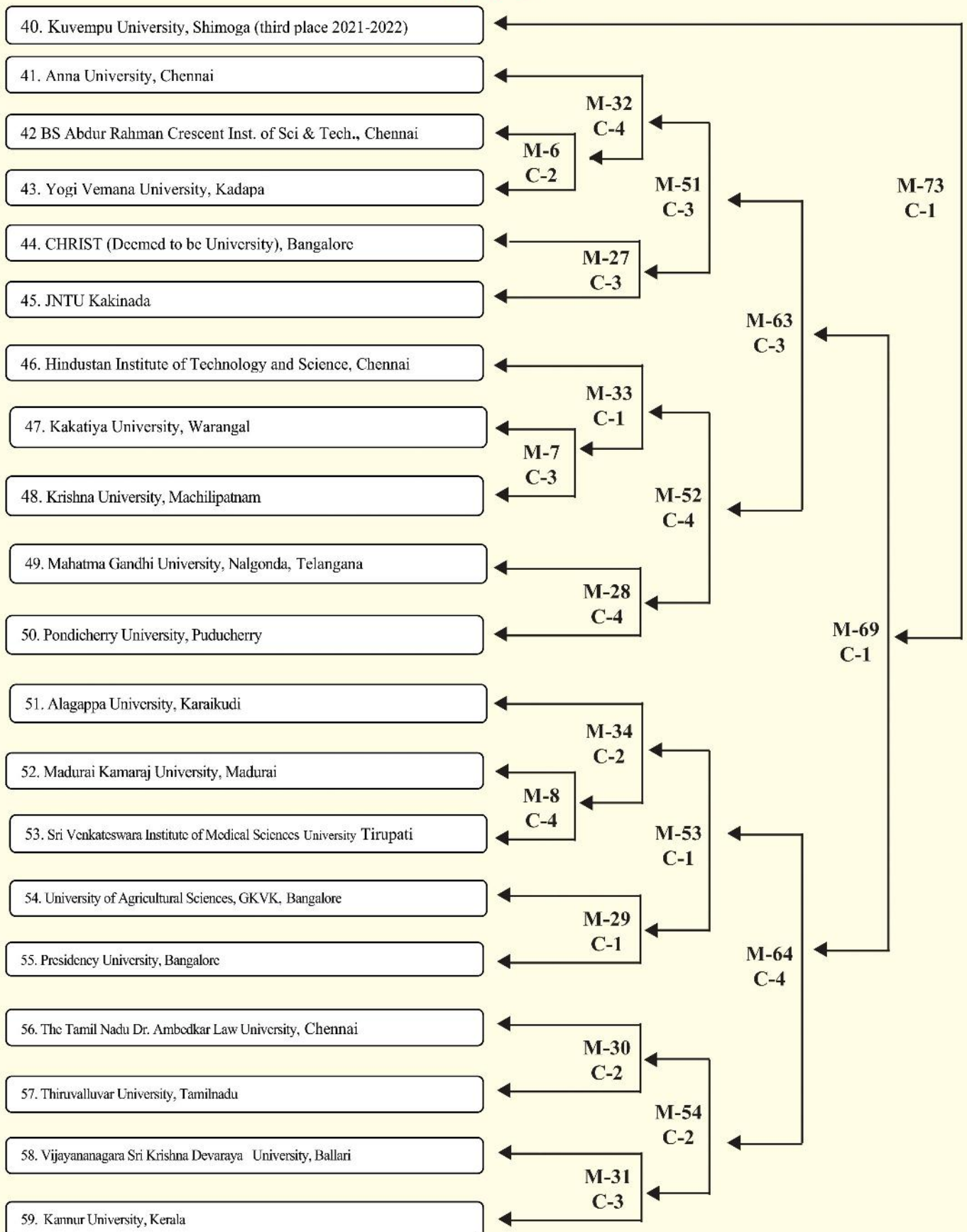

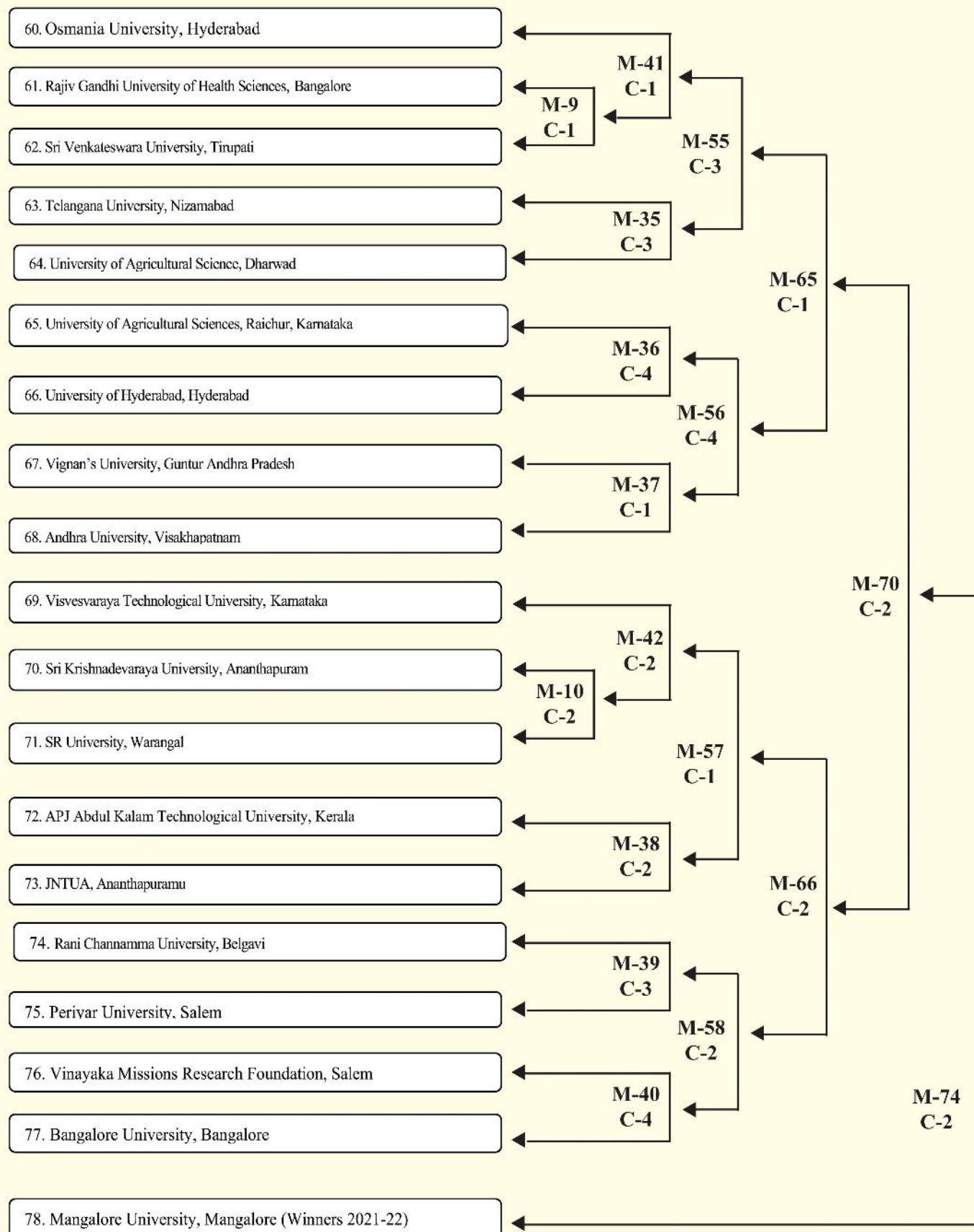
